


The Twitter Protocol

The Twitter protocol forces students to reflect in a very concise manner. Here are the constraints of the protocol:

- What is something you learned today either about yourself or in general? (Cannot be  any longer than 140 characters).
- Have an accompanying picture/meme that sums up your feelings.
- Add a hashtag to it as well that shows what you are going to improve for next time.

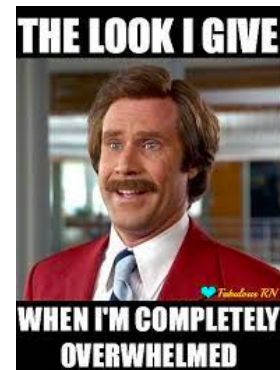

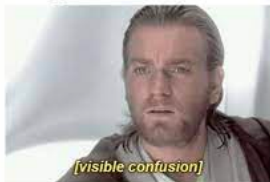
