Initiating Activity

This is doing a planned activity that provides a sampling of what process is going to be used to learn the forthcoming content. For example, a teacher has planned that students will read from resources and then show comprehension skills to answer questions about what they have learned. The initiating activity could have students read a short passage and then write or discuss what they learned. If students are able to do this with ease, then maybe the teacher figures out how to add analysis and evaluation to the reading of the resources to better challenge the students.
