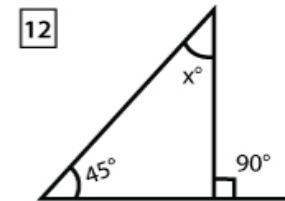
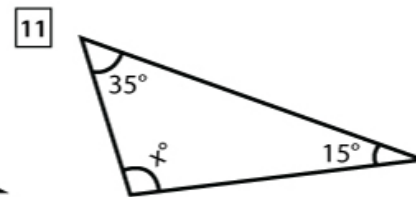
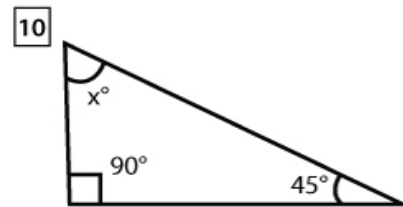
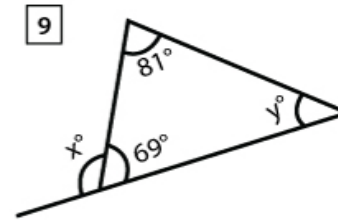
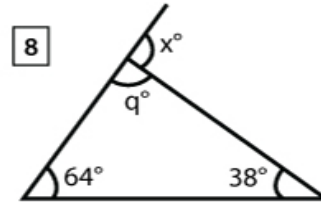
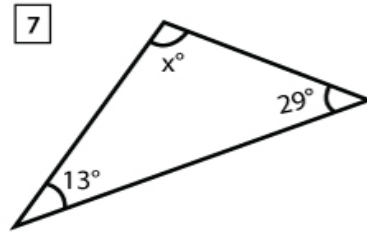
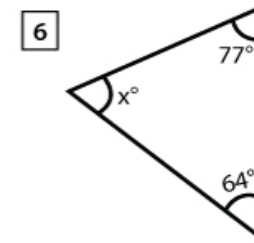
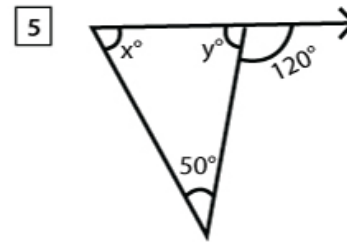
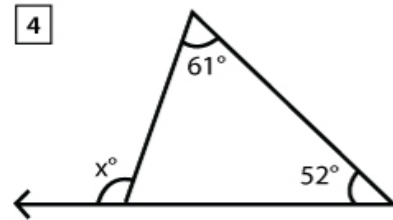
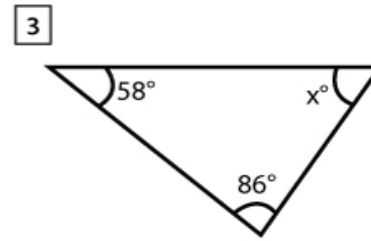
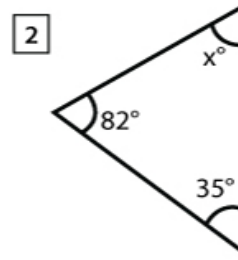
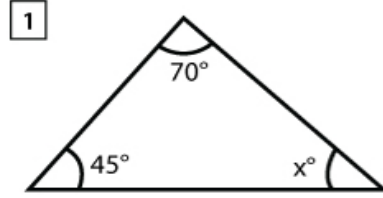


Most Difficult First
